The interdisciplinary workshop is offered by the SOCUM-Fellows Prof. Bruce Haddock and Dr. Peri Roberts from Cardiff University (Wales). The workshop's theme is very much the principled basis of a defensible multicultural or plural society. In many ways, of course, this is a matter of political theory catching up with the way the world has gone. But multiculturalism as a concept has been exposed to much harsher political criticism over the last 5 years, so it is timely to look again at the normative case.

Haddock and Roberts have engaged with this topic in a collaborative project over the last ten years. Three multi-authored volumes have already been published by the fellows (*Multiculturalism, Identity and Rights*, 2003, *Principles and Political Order: The Challenge of Diversity*, 2006, and *Evil in Contemporary Political Theory*, 2011).

After registration, you will be provided with the workshop readings. Participants are expected to work through the texts before the workshop and to prepare questions and critical remarks for discussion.
