

Born of Indian ancestry in Ireland and raised in Trinidad, Mootoo moved to Canada at age 19. Her experiences as a multiple immigrant (India, Ireland, England, Trinidad and Canada) shape and color her writing.

Mootoo's debut novel, *Cereus Blooms at Night* (1996) won the New England Book Sellers Award in 1998. It was shortlisted for the Giller Prize and longlisted for the Man Booker Prize.

Mootoo currently teaches in the Creative Writing Program in the School of Continuing Education at the University of Toronto.
